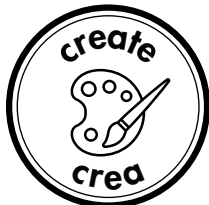


Welcome to Summer at Austin Public Library 2024!

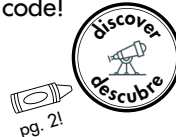

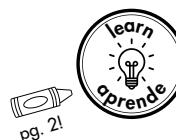

CREATE ACTIVITY BADGE

Complete one (1) of the activities below, then color the badge on page 2 when you are done!

- Create a DIY nature journal
Step 1: Gather supplies: paper, cardboard or brown paper bag, hole punch, string or cord, scissors, nature items to decorate the cover

Step 2: Cut paper into squares to make the pages

Step 3: Make the covers by cutting two pieces of cardboard or brown paper bag slightly larger than your paper squares

Step 4: Carefully stack the paper in between the covers, and punch 2-3 holes along one long edge

Step 5: Thread string or cord through the holes and tie a knot

Step 6: Decorate the cover using nature items!

- Create a DIY nature crown
Step 1: Gather supplies: flexible cardboard or a brown paper bag, tape, strong glue, nature items

Step 2: Measure head size, cut the cardboard or brown paper bag into a 2-3" strip, and tape the ends together to form a circle for the crown

Step 3: Collect nature items! Leaves, bark, acorns, and twigs all make great decorations!

Step 4: Carefully use strong glue like hot glue or super glue to carefully decorate your crown.
